Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Panipat as the petitioner-wife is residing at village Samchana, District Rohtak alongwith minor daughter aged about 7 years and it is very difficult for her to manage competently and effectively to pursue her defence in the petition filed under Section 13 of the Act at Panipat as the distance between village Samchana to Panipat is more than 80 Kms. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC for claiming maintenance for her as well as for minor daughter against the husband, respondent herein, at Rohtak.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Rohtak. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
