Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) for restitution of conjugal rights filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Ludhiana to Sangrur as the petitioner-wife is residing with her parents at village Mohali Kalan, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur alongwith two minor children i.e. son Komalpreet Singh, aged about 7 years and a daughter Pawanpreet Kaur, aged about one year.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana is transferred to District Judge, Sangrur, who would send the same to the court of competent jurisdiction at Malerkotla. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
