Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Amritsar to Moga.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is already facing proceedings in a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the petitioner at Moga. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel Moga to Amritsar on each and every date of hearing along with her minor child.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Amritsar is transferred to Family Court, Moga. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
