Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Sirsa to Hisar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC as also under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Hansi, in addition to two more cases, i.e., one under 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, and another under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Hisar.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Sirsa is transferred to Family Court, Hisar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
