Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Ambala to Jalandhar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings in FIR No.71 dated 5.9.2014, besides the petitioner has also filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Jalandhar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 200 kilometers from Jalandhar to Ambala on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ambala is transferred to District Judge, Jalandhar who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
