**Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J.** (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Jagraon to Patiala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is already facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC besides a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the petitioner-wife at Patiala. It is further claimed that it would be very difficult for the petitioner to undertake journey of 120 kilometers from Patiala to Jagraon on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Jagraon is transferred to District Judge, Patiala who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
