Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Chandigarh to Kaithal.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is already facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Kaithal. It is further claimed that it would be very difficult for the petitioner to undertake long journey from Kalayat (Kaithal) to Chandigarh on each and every date of hearing along with her two minor children.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Chandigarh is transferred to District Judge, Kaithal who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
