SNEH PRASHAR, J.

This petition under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent-husband from the court of Additional District Judge, Amritsar to the court of District Judge, Ludhiana was filed by Kamalprit Kaur-wife.

Power of Attorney on behalf of the respondent has been filed. Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that as per instruction from the respondent he has no objection to the transfer of the petition from the Court of Additional District Judge, Amritsar to learned District Judge, Ludhiana as per prayer made by the petitioner in the instant petition.

Otherwise also, as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, there are two other cases arising out of the marital discord

between the parties pending at Ludhiana. There is a small daughter aged 1-1/2 years born out of the wedlock of the parties who is in custody of the petitioner. The distance between Ludhiana and Amritsar is more than 150 kilometers and it is indeed inconvenient for the petitioner to travel such a long distance alongwith the minor child to defend the petition filed by the respondent.

Accordingly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before Additional District Judge, Amritsar is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana. The file shall be sent by the trial Court to the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, who will either keep the petition himself/herself or will entrust the same to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The parties are directed to appear before the District Judge, Ludhiana on 28.09.2015.
