Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioners seeks transfer of the civil suit titled as “Sukhwinder Kaur and another v. LIC and others”, filed by the petitioner in the court of Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Jalandhar to a court of competent jurisdiction at Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

It is urged that since the dispute involves inheritance of claim arising on insurance policy due to death of the husband of the petitioner, the petitioner apprehends threat perception at the hands of private respondents as also lot of hardship and inconvenience in travelling 100 kilometers from Anandpur Sahib to Jalandhar on each and every date of hearing, when petitioner No.2 is a minor child of 5 years of age.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the aforesaid suit pending at Jalandhar is transferred to District Judge, Ropar who may assign it to any competent court at Anandpur Sahib. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 30.4.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
