Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Jhajjar to Sonapat as the petitioner is residing with her father and two minor children at village Sersa, District Sonapat which is approximately 60 Kms away from Jhajjar.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Sonapat. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Sonapat and has also got registered a case bearing FIR No.259 of 2013, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, Kundli, District Sonapat against the husband-respondent. It is further urged that a petition for custody of minor children instituted by the respondent-husband has already been transferred from Bahadurgarh to Sonapat by this Court vide order dated 15.1.2015 passed in TA No.732 of 2014.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar is transferred to District Judge, Sonapat. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
