SNEH PRASHAR, J.

This petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure was filed by Smt. Kavita-wife seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, “the Act of 1955”) by the respondent-husband from the court of learned Additional District Judge, Yamunanagar at Jagadhri to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Karnal.

Reply filed by the respondent in Court today is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

At this stage, the respondent submitted that he has no objection to the transfer of the petition from the Court of Additional District Judge, Yamunanagar at Jagadhri to Karnal as per prayer made by the petitioner in the instant petition.

Otherwise also, as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, four other cases arising out of the marital discord between the parties were pending/ decided at Karnal. One male child born out of the wedlock of the parties is in custody of the petitioner. The distance between Yamunanagar and Karnal is more than 60 kilometers and it will indeed be inconvenient for the petitioner to travel such a distance alongwith the minor child to attend the hearing in the Court and defend the petition filed by the respondent.

Accordingly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act of 1955 pending before Additional District Judge, Yamunanagar at Jagadhri is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the court of competent jurisdiction at Karnal. The file shall be sent by the trial court to the District and Sessions Judge, Karnal within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, who will either keep the petition himself/ herself or will entrust the same to any other court of competent jurisdiction at Karnal.

The parties are directed to appear before the District Judge, Karnal on 06.01.2016.
