Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Amritsar to Kapurthala as the petitioner is residing with her old grandfather at Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has earlier filed a petition under Section 13 of the Act for dissolution of marriage by way of a decree of divorce at Kapurthala, but as a counter blast, the husband, respondent herein, has now filed the aforementioned petition under Section 9 of the Act at Amritsar.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar is transferred to District Judge, Kapurthala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
