Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Kalka, District Panchkula to Jalandhar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Jalandhar. Besides this, the petitioner has to take care of her minor child and thus it is very difficult for her to travel 150 kilometers from Jalandhar to Kalka on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition bearing No.17 of 2014 and titled as 'Lalit Kumar v. Pooja' under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Kalka is transferred to Jalandhar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
