Prayer in the CM is for placing on record Annexure A-3, copy of complaint made to SSP, Jalandhar (Rural).

Allowed, subject to all just exceptions and the document is taken on record.

Main case

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Panchkula to Jalandhar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Phillaur (Jalandhar). Besides this, there being imminent threat perception to her life and liberty at the hands of the respondent and his relatives, as has been depicted in the complaint Annexure A-3, it will be very difficult and harmful for her to travel all alone

a distance of about 125 kilometers from Jalandhar to Panchkula in absence of a competent male member in her family, on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequely, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Panchkula is transferred to Jalandhar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
