**Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J.** (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Panipat to Rohtak.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband and his other family members also faced criminal trial inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Rohtak in which they were convicted and the institution of the petition under Section 13 of the Act is a retaliatory move. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 75 kilometers from Rohtak to Panipat on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before District Judge, Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Rohtak. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
