Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Ludhiana to Ferozepur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Ferozepur. Besides this, distance between Ludhiana and Ferozepur is about 120 kilometers and she being unemployed and there being no competent male member in her family to accompany her to Ludhiana on each and every date of hearing, she will have to face great hardship.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to Ferozepur. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
