Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce, from the court of District Judge, Jind to a court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings under Section 12 of of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 as also another complaint inter-alia under Section 498-A at Patiala. Besides this, distance between Patiala and Jind is approximately 140 kilometers and the petitioner being a household lady having no source of income, it will be very difficult for her to travel to and fro Patiala and Jind on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before District Judge, Jind is transferred to Patiala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
