KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks the transfer of the divorce petition from Bathinda to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Mansa. The perusal of the grounds show that in this case, the evidence of the petitioner has been completed and the case was fixed for evidence of the respondent. On the first date of hearing, no evidence of the respondent was produced. Now, the case is again fixed for evidence of the respondent.

I am of the view that since most of the trial has already completed, there is no ground to transfer the case from Bathinda to Mansa.

The application stands dismissed.
