Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Faridabad to Ludhiana as the petitioner is residing with her parents at Khanna, District Ludhiana which is approximately 310 Kms away from Khanna.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 13 of the Act against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Ludhiana.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before District Judge (Family Court), Faridabad is transferred to District Judge,

Ludhiana. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
