Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Sections 7, 10 & 12 of the Guardian & Wards Act, 1890 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for custody of the minor child from Panipat to Hisar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 as also under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Hisar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 120 kilometers from Hisar to on each and every date of hearing along with her minor son.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Sections 7, 10 & 12 of the Guardian & Wards Act, 1890 at Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Hisar who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
