Prayer in the CM is for placing on record copy of the complaint made to Commissioner of Police, Amritsar and FIR dated 10.2.2015 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Allowed, subject to all just exceptions and the documents are taken on record.

Main case

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for grant of judicial separation from Moga to Amritsar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Amritsar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 115 kilometers from Amritsar to Moga on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before Additional District Judge, Moga is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
