Through this application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, the applicant-appellant seeks condonation of delay of 1 day in filing the appeal. In view of the averments made in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the delay of 1

day in filing the present appeal is condoned.

RSA No. 4957 of 2014

Impugned in the present regular second appeal is the judgment and decree dated 06.05.2014 passed by the Learned Additional District Judge, Narnaul affirming the judgment and decree dated 09.12.2010 passed by then Civil Judge (Junior Division), Narnaul.

Plaintiff had sued the defendants Gram Panchayat and the state for permanent injunction, claiming that he is in possession of the suit land since 1933. Both the Courts below have found that the Khasra Girdawaries are in favour of Gram Panchayat and that the plaintiff has failed to prove his possession. There are concurrent findings of facts of both the Courts below. No substantial question of law arises.

Hence, the present appeal is dismissed.
