The present appeal has been preferred by the appellant-plaintiff against the judgment and decree dated 25.07.2014, vide which his claim in appeal has been accepted by the District Judge, Mansa, but interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the delayed payment of medical reimbursement amount has been granted, whereas the appellant asserts that he is entitled to the present bank rate, which is 9%.

2. Having perused the judgment passed by the Lower Appellate Court, I am of the considered view that the interest, as has been granted by the said Court, is fully justified, which do not call for any interference by this Court.

3. No substantial question of law arises in the present appeal, which requires adjudication by this Court.

4. Finding no merit in the present appeal, the same stands dismissed.
