There is a joint application filed by the plaintiff-respondent and defendant-appellant under Order XXIII Rules 1 and 3 read with Section 151 CPC for seeking permission of this Court to abandon the claim originally made in the suit and for passing a decree in favour of the parties as per the compromise deed dated 2.7.2015. Original compromise deed has been attached with the application. The same is taken on record and marked as “C1”.

It has been pointed out that both the parties to the lis are present in the Court and have been identified by their respective counsel and they

do not dispute the execution of the compromise deed.

Since the main case is listed for 17.9.2015, I deem it appropriate to prepone the hearing of the appeal and decide the main case in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

The main case is taken on board.

The Regular Second Appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise dated 2.7.2015 as the plaintiff has abandoned the original claim in the suit. The parties shall be bound by the compromise and the same be made part of the order.

Decree stands modified in terms of the compromise.
