Impugned in the present second regular appeal is the judgment dated 02.09.2014 passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Fazilka, affirming the judgment dated 20.07.2012 passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Fazilka.

Briefly stated, the plaintiff (respondent herein) had filed a suit for recovery of ₹1,53,500/-. The suit was decreed by the lower court vide order dated 20.07.2012. The appeal filed by the present petitioner was dismissed by the learned Addl. District Judge, Fazilka vide order dated 02.09.2014.

The suit was filed on the basis of account books.

From the perusal of judgments of both the courts below, this Court finds that only question of fact was involved, which was decided by both the courts below. No substantial question of law much less question of law arises in this case.

Hence, the present appeal is dismissed.
