Prayer has been made for condonation of 88 days delay in filing the appeal.

In view of the grounds mentioned in the application, CM stands allowed and delay 88 days in filing the appeal stands condoned and CM stands disposed of.

RSA No.694 of 2014

Present appeal is against concurrent findings of both the Courts below whereby suit for permanent injunction filed by the appellant was dismissed by Court of first instance.

Appeal filed against said judgment was also dismissed mainly on the ground that plaintiff failed to prove the possession on the property for which she was seeking injunction. The evidence available in file has

already been appreciated by both the Courts below. Two substantial questions of law are involved in this case.

There are no grounds for intervention by way of present RSA and the same stands dismissed.
