K.Kannan, J. (Oral)

There is a prayer for adjournment. I decline the same taking note of the fact that there have been persistent absence or pleas of adjournments ever since the appeal was filed in January 2014. At one time, this court dismissed the appeal for non-prosecution on 16.12.2014 and on application for restoration, it had been restored. Again after restoration on 27.02.2015, there was no representation and the case was adjourned to March, 2015. On the subsequent day also, there was no representation and it was adjourned to July, 2015. In July 2015, there was still a request for

adjournment, it was adjourned. I find no justification for the persistent pleas for adjournments and finding the plea for adjournment brought before the court to be wholly unreasonable and unjustified, appeal is dismissed for default for non-prosecution.
