1. The petition for transfer is by the wife of matrimonial proceedings which is pending before the Family Court at Patiala. The wife is residing at Jagraon, District Ludhiana and it is stated that the distance between the places is more than 140 kilometers. The petitioner (wife) is hard put to meet herself and the minor daughter who is living with her. She has no source of income and even the maintenance awarded has not been paid for the last 2 months. She, therefore, seeks for a transfer of the matrimonial proceedings to the Family Court at Ludhiana which is nearer to her place of residence.

2. The counsel for the respondent states that he is a retired army person and the petitioner has gone out of the matrimonial

house of her own and, therefore, she will not seek for a transfer of the proceedings to a court of her convenience.

3. I find there are adequate reasons for a transfer when the petitioner has a minor child to take care and she has herself no financial resources to support herself. The petition for transfer is allowed and the case pending before the Family Court at Patiala under the title “Karamjit Singh Versus Ravinder Kaur” is ordered to be withdrawn and transferred to the Family Court at Ludhiana.

4. Parties shall appear before the Family Court at Ludhiana on 01.05.2015.
