The petition for transfer is for a suit instituted by the wife in the court at Ludhiana for the relief of injunction. It appears that the matrimonial proceedings initiated by the husband in the court at Ludhiana had been transferred to the court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar. The petitioner had earlier filed an application for transfer and they had all been transferred to the court at Jalandhar. She would want this case also to be transferred to the court at Jalandhar. I find no justification for a transfer for the only reason that the matrimonial proceedings have been transferred. A suit for injunction in respect of a property situate in Ludhiana filed by her in the court at Ludhiana ought to be tried only in the court at

Ludhiana and unless there are very special circumstances that dictate transfer, a mere convenience cannot be a ground for a transfer. The petition is dismissed.
