By filing TA No. 135 of 2014, Ms. Jyoti Rana, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, Sachin Rana, from Patiala to Hisar.

Sachin Rana has filed TA No. 501 of 2014 seeking transfer of petition filed under Section 18 of the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956 filed by Ms. Jyoti Rana, from Hisar to Patiala.

Learned counsel for the wife [Ms. Jyoti Rana] urges that the petitioner is residing with her parents and the two minor children at Hisar.

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It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Hisar. Besides this, distance between Hisar and Patiala is about 170 kilometers and she being a lady and there being no suitable male member in her family to accompany her to Patiala on each and every date of hearing, she is facing great hardship.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the husband has resisted the claim of the petitioner-wife.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request of the wife is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Patiala is transferred to District Judge [Family Court], Hisar. Both the concerned Courts to comply. TA No. 135 of 2014 is allowed. TA No. 501 of 2014 filed by the husband [Sachin Rana] has no merit and is accordingly dismissed.
