Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

There is CM No.5166-CII of 2015 for placing on record written statement and Annexures R-1 to R-4. Allowed, as prayed for, subject to all just exceptions.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for annulment of marriage, from Jalandhar to Amritsar.

It is urged that the petitioner belongs to a poor family having no source of income and the family cannot shoulder the burden of litigation and travelling expenses owing to the fact that there are two younger sisters and one younger brother in the family, who is still pursuing his studies. It is urged that on the contrary, the respondent belongs to a well to do business family. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 90 kilometers from Amritsar to Jalandhar on each and every date of hearing in view of her peculiar financial status.

This petition has been resisted by the respondent-husband vide Annexure R-4 claiming that he is suffering from depression and was also hospitalized.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them however, notwithstanding the resistance by the respondent, in view of the peculiar circumstances in which the petitioner is placed, the request is allowed.

Sequely, the petition under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Jalandhar is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
