Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Gurdaspur to Hoshiarpur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Hoshiarpur. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 100 kilometers from Hoshiarpur to Gurdaspur on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Gurdaspur is transferred to Hoshiarpur. Both the

concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
