Despite service of the respondent, there is no representation on his behalf right from 8.9.2014. Even today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent. He is, consequently, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Hisar to Patiala as the petitioner is residing alongwith her brother at Patiala, which is more than 178 Kms. away from Patiala.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a complaint, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC as also a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against the respondent-husband, which are pending adjudication in the court at Patiala.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge (Family Court), Hisar is transferred to District Judge, Patiala who may further assign the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction there. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
