Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Jhajjar to Fatehabad.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also proceedings under various provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Fatehabad. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 200 kilometers from Fatehabad to Jhajjar on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Jhajjar is transferred to District Judge, Fatehabad who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
