Reply filed in Court today, is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Sangrur to Ambala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at the instance of the petitioner as also in an FIR registered by the Ambala Police for suicidal attempt by the respondent. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to undertake long journey from Ambala to Sangrur on each and every date of hearing.

The respondent has strongly resisted the prayer made by the petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequely, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Sangrur is transferred to Family Court, Ambala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 12.6.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
