2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Sangrur to Mansa as the petitioner is residing with her parents and one son at Mansa.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Mansa and has also got registered a case bearing FIR No.76 dated 19.08.2013, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, City Mansa against the husband-respondent and his family members.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Sangrur is transferred to District Judge, Mansa. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
