**Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):**

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Panchkula to Rewari.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under various provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Rewari. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 400 kilometers from Rewari to Panchkula on each and every date of hearing along with her minor child and it will be a four-days affair for her to attend the proceedings at Panchkula court on each date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Panchkula is transferred to District Judge, Rewari who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
