Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Sangrur to Ludhiana.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under various provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Ludhiana. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 100 kilometers from Ludhiana to Sangrur on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Sangrur is transferred to District Judge, Ludhiana who

may assign it to any other competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 23.4.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
