Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Jind to Kurukshetra as the petitioner is residing with her parents and an infant daughter about six months old at Kurukshetra, which is approximately 100 Kms. away from her place of residence.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Kurukshetra. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against the respondent-husband at Kurukshetra.

3. Perusal of the paper book reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the respondent despite service through his

mother on the previous date of hearing i.e. 13.10.2014. Similar is the position even today. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jind is transferred to District Judge, Kurukshetra, who may further transfer the same to the competent court of jurisdiction under him. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
