Application has filed this petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC' for short) for transfer of the case bearing No.HMA 23515/1381012 (Old Case No.HMA817857/12) titled as "Baldev Raj versus Pooja".

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is maintaining her minor child and it is difficult for her to travel to Amritsar on each date of hearing. Three cases between the parties are already pending in the Courts at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on the other hand has opposed the application.

Respondent has filed petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 ('Act' for short) against the applicant.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant, it would be just and expedient to transfer the petition under Section 9 of the Act from the Court of

Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar as three other cases are already pending between the parties at Jalandhar. Moreover, petitioner is maintaining her minor child and it must be difficult for her to travel to Amritsar on each date of hearing.

Accordingly, this application is allowed. Case No.HMA 23515/1381012 (Old Case No.HMA817857/12) titled as “Baldev Raj versus Pooja” is withdrawn from the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar and is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.
