There is no appearance on behalf of the respondent though earlier he was represented through Mr. Dhirender Chopra, Advocate. As such, the respondent is proceeded against ex-parte.

Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of suit for restitution of conjugal rights filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Malerkotla, District Sangrur to Taran Taran as the petitioner is residing at village Bania, Tehsil Khadur Sahib, District Taran Taran at her sister's house as her parents have already expired.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband which is pending adjudication in the court at Taran Taran.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the suit for restitution of conjugal rights pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Malerkotla, District Sangrur is transferred to District Judge, Taran Taran. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
