Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Jhajjar to Hisar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings in a criminal complaint as also proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Hisar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 120 kilometers from Hisar to Jhajjar on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Jhajjar is transferred to Family Court, Hisar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
