Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Sangrur to Patiala as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents and a minor daughter aged 1 year and 3 months at Patiala, which is approximately 120 Kms. away from Sangrur.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also got registered a case, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC against the respondent-husband and his family members at Patiala. Besides this, she has also instituted a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent in the court at Patiala.

3. Counsel for the respondent states that he has no objection in allowing this transfer application.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge, Sangrur is transferred to District Judge, Patiala who may further assign the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction there. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
