Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of civil suit [Annexure P/1] filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Amritsar as the petitioner-wife, alongwith her son, is residing at her parental house in Gurdaspur and it is very difficult for the petitioner-wife to manage and pursue the proceedings competently and effectively in the suit filed by her husband by travelling from Gurdaspur to attend the dates of hearing in the said suit at Amritsar. It is further claimed that the husband is also residing at Gurdaspur

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a suit [Annexure P/4] inter alia, against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Gurdaspur.

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In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner, as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the suit titled **Raj Kumar Vs. Janak Dulari** pending before Civil Judge [Junior Division], Amritsar is transferred to the Court of District Judge, Gurdaspur who would assign it to a Court of competent jurisdiction under him. Both the concerned Courts to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
