Reply filed on behalf of the respondent today in Court is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights, from Kapurthala to a court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband had appeared before the Women Cell at Moga in connection with the complaint made by the petitioner regarding the constant harassment and torture meted out to the petitioner and, thus, she apprehends imminent threat perception. Besides this, the petitioner has to look after her school going minor son of about four and a half years age. In these circumstances, it will be very difficult to commute between Kapurthala and Moga on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequely, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Kapurthala is transferred to Moga. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
