**K.C.PURI.J.(ORAL)**

This is a petition under Section 24 of CPC for transfer of civil suit titled as Mahender Singh vs. Geeta from the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar to Sonapat.

It is pleaded that marriage between the parties was solemnized on 22.1.2012. There was demand of dowry. The petitioner wife filed petition under Section 9 of HMA. The respondent has moved an application for transfer of the said case but that was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 14.8.2013 passed in TA No. 598 of 2012 observing that the petitioner is unable to defend the case at a far distant place.

The prayer has been opposed by learned counsel for the respondent.

In the order dated 14.8.2013, this Court has already

observed that petitioner has poor condition and convenience of the wife

has to be taken in account. She is unable to travel for such a long distance. So, in these circumstances, the aforesaid case titled as Mahender Singh vs. Geeta stands withdrawn from the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar and stands transferred to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sonapat. The Civil Judge (Senior Division) may keep the file on his own board or may entrust to any other court of competent jurisdiction. The file be sent to the transferee Court forthwith.
