Counsel for the petitioner claims that two matters one pertaining to FIR No.35 dated 11.04.2012 registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar under Section 498A, 420, 406, 506 IPC and another FIR under Section 420, 494 IPC lodged by father of the respondent-husband against the petitioner-wife are pending adjudication at Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner further urges that even a case filed by the petitioner under Section 12 of Protection of the Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is pending adjudication at Amritsar where the respondent-husband had been appearing and is participating in the proceedings.

It is claimed that the respondent-husband filed petition under Section 11 of Hindu Marriage Act at Mohali in order to harass and pressurize the

petitioner-wife.

In view of the circumstances explained above, petition under Section 11 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is ordered to be transferred from Mohali to Amritsar.

Compliance be made by all concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
