There is no representation on behalf of the respondent. Even on the last date of hearing there was no representation on behalf of the respondent. Therefore, he is proceeded against exparte.

2. In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Patiala to Ludhiana as the petitioner is residing at Ludhiana which is approximately 90 Kms. away from Patiala.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Ludhiana.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patiala, is transferred to District Judge, Ludhiana who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.

7. Parties are directed to appear before the court below on 22.04.2015.
