SNEH PRASHAR, J.

This petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure (for short, "C.P.C.") was filed by the petitioners seeking transfer of civil suit No.147 of 10.08.2011 pending in the Court of Shri Mahesh Kumar, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur to the N.R.I. Court, Jalandhar (newly created) Exclusive Court to dispose of N.R.I. cases.

The submissions made by learned counsel representing the petitioners and learned counsel representing the respondents have been considered.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they (plaintiffs

in the case) are residents of Canada and have filed the present suit through their special power of attorney holder Tejinder Pal Singh Sohi. The petitioner No.2 is an old woman and is entitled to speedy trial of the case, therefore, the case be sent to the newly created N.R.I. Court, Jalandhar so that the case can be disposed of at the earliest.

During the proceedings of this petition, report of District Judge, Hoshiarpur was called. Alongwith his report, the District Judge, Hoshiarpur has sent the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur which reveals that the new N.R.I. Court created at Jalandhar is dealing with the cases pertaining to Jalandhar jurisdiction only and so far there is no instruction from this Court to transfer all pending cases of N.R.I. in the State of Punjab to the newly created N.R.I. Court at Jalandhar.

In the above premises, the case of the petitioners pending at Hoshiarpur could not be transferred to N.R.I. Court, Jalandhar and the petition is dismissed.
