Reply on behalf of the respondent has not been filed even today though counsel for the respondent had sought adjournment on the previous date of hearing i.e. 03.03.2015 for this purpose. Request for adjournment for filing reply, thus, is declined.

In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Kapurthala to Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur as the petitioner is residing with her parents and two minor children aged about 2 year and 1 ½ month respectively at village Harshi, Tehsil Dasuya, Distt. Hoshiarpur, which is approximately 100 Kms. away from Kapurthala.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition

under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Dasuya.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kapurthala is transferred to District Judge, Hoshiarpur who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
